Minutes from July 6, 2026 Meeting

- 1) Meeting called to order: 6:57pm
- 2) Roll call:
 - a) Present: Rudolph, Trumbower, Levzow, Burbach, Balsiger, McGuire

- 3) Approval of agenda
 - a) Motion to approve: Ralph

- 5) Treasurer report – Ralph made a mistake last month on the amount for the paint, but he corrected it.
 - a) Current balance: \$27,840.14 + \$5000 in CD
 - b) Motion to approve Treasurer's Report: Lori
 - c) 2nd: Doug
 - d) Motion carries
- 6) Citizen comments: They want a representative from our board ...cancelled and rescheduled for August 5th @ 5:30pm. Ralph was going to go to it anyway. There's supposed to be a representative from the tax districts.
 - a) Someone commented on the Hwy. 44 boat landing on Facebook. There isn't a rock there, it's the ground. Powerloading is causing some of it, but it's also just a shallow landing. Ben saw that someone backed into one of the signs at the boat landing with their trailer, as well, snapping it off. There used to be a buoy there, but it's gone now.
- 7) General Business
 - a) Signage for Hwy. 44 Boat Landing: Signage will be about \$420 and buoy around \$308, so we could spend up to \$800 for signage and a buoy.
 - i) Motion to spend up to \$800 at the Hwy. 44 boat landing for signage and a buoy.: Doug
 - ii) 2nd: Ralph
 - iii) Motion carries.
 - b) Grant Update: The village has not notified us that they've received the money yet. They thought it would be there in mid-July, so they should

- hopefully have it by next meeting.
- c) Frog Pond Treatment Update: The DNR came and looked at it and said there's good plant life, fish are on their beds, and it's a good habitat, so no need for treatment.
 - d) Fish Stocking Update: Cam has everything ready to go for September/October with the DNR. It will be the same mix we've stocked before. Gollon has northern they'd like to stock before the end of August, to give them time to spawn. This was not budgeted for earlier, but we need them to help keep the white shad population down.
 - i) Motion to spend up to \$9000 on fish: Doug
 - ii) 2nd: Lori
 - iii) Motion carries.
 - e) North Bay Pier Update:
 - i) Commercial Recreations Specialists quote is \$18,110, for 4-ft wide, not installed.
 - ii) Instant Pier's quote is \$18,311 installed, so it's comparable to the other two quotes we had. So for \$200 more, we get it installed and it includes a kayak launch. He's also local.
 - (1) Motion to approve Instant Pier Service's bid of \$18,311 for the North Bay boat landing.: Ralph
 - (2) 2nd: Darrell
 - (3) Motion carries.
 - f) Mural Painting of Stormwater Drains Update
 - g) Discussion for the Annual Meeting and Budget: Ralph highlighted our big projects of the past 3 years.
 - i) We completed:
 - the kayak launch and pier in 2023
 - the handicap beach mat in 2024
 - the raft, bought buoys and decoys, and made the fish cribs in 2025
 - ii) This year: we have \$3600 in taxes coming, we got \$5000 from the car show, and we wrote the check for the handicap pier for \$12,000.
 - iii) We'll be over budget by around \$6000, but with the \$3600 in taxes coming in, along with the \$4200, we will be ok.
 - h) Donation to the Summer School Fishing Program and the Pardeeville Ice Fishing team. We'll table this until next meeting, to give Steve time to talk to Kurt Calkins.
- 8) Other Notes: Doug asked what we can do to get more people familiar with the lake. We can talk more about how to use our education budget. People need to be educated on boater's safety, using life jackets, etc.
